



## TRAVEL AND CONFERENCE BURSARY

The Travel Awards Scheme was introduced in 2004 to promote scientific communications at major international meetings. Applicants whose work is/has been selected for presentation will be favoured. Please note the Society meetings are **excluded** from these awards.

### The terms and conditions of the Travel and Conference Bursary are as follows:

1. **Concessionary members of the Society in good standing for at least 12 months and Undergraduate Members.** Members who are in substantive NHS consultant, academic or similar permanent positions are **ineligible** for this scheme.
2. A sum of up to £500 will be available to cover the costs of travel and/or registration fees and must **supplement** monies from other sources. Evidence of monies from other sources must be provided with the application.
3. The Society logo must be used on all presentations.
4. A one-page report of the value of the meeting must be sent to the Society office within three months of attending the meeting. **Failure to provide a report will preclude future support in this and other schemes run by the Society.**
5. The Society will normally withdraw funding if the grant is not acknowledged and accepted within 6 months of the offer

Applications are reviewed upon receipt by a sub-committee chaired by the Meetings Secretary.
