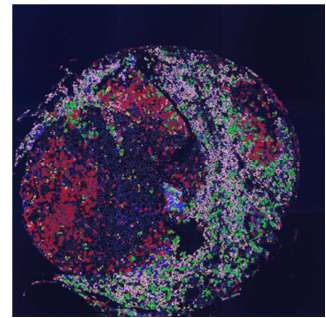
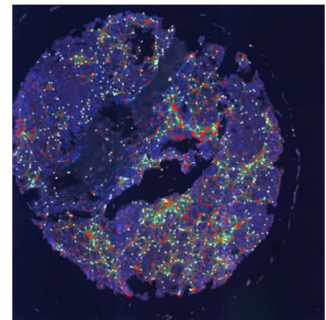

Travel to the venue/hotel

By train:

Manchester Oxford Road is the closest train station and is a 20 minute walk from the venue, although there are also numerous buses that stop in close proximity to the venue.

There is a direct bus from Manchester Piccadilly to the hospital complex (147), that runs from 7:20 to 18:30 every 10 minutes.

By car:

If you will be travelling to the venue by car, please contact Nadia Ezzedine (nadia.ezzedine@manchester.ac.uk), who will be able to arrange parking for you on campus.

To/from the hotel/venue:

The hotel is located in Piccadilly Gardens, 2 minutes from the main bus station where there are numerous buses that will take you right outside CityLabs – simply ask for CityLabs or Manchester Royal Infirmary

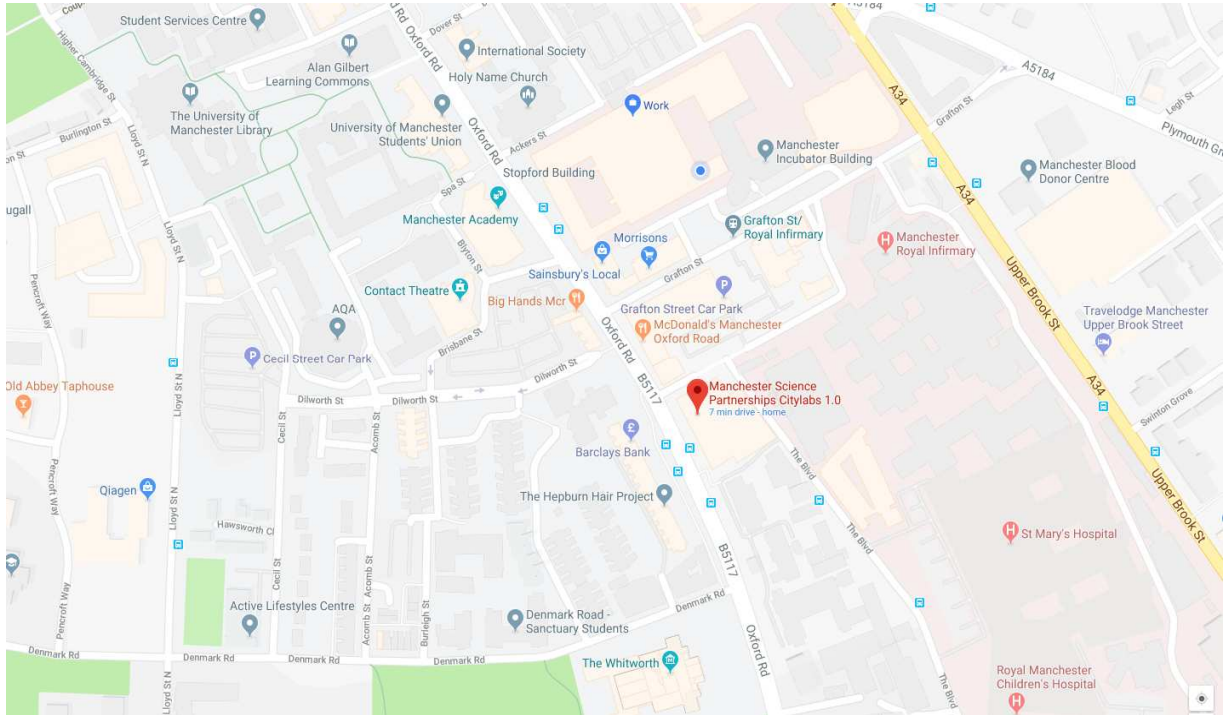
